

Calving supplies

- Bucket and warm water
- Disinfectant (chlorhexidine or povidone)-always diluted with warm water
- OB Chains or straps and handles, calf puller +/- snare
- OB sleeves and Exam gloves
- OB Lube-Gallon or dry
- Waterproof bibs and top
- Clean towels and/or paper towels
- Naval dip
- Dental floss or suture
- Bottle and nipple
- Oral calf feeder or enema bag
- Powdered colostrum
- Syringes and needles (18 gauge is nice for calves and 16 gauge for cows)
- Tags, tag marker, tagger
- Thermometer
- Oxytocin
- Penicillin
- Long acting antibiotic (examples: Draxxin, Excede or Excenel, oxytetracycline)
- Dexamethasone and Meloxicam or Flunixin (Banamine, Prevail, etc).
- Oral Electrolytes
- Probios
- Vet's phone number handy!

The following for certain operations:

- Injectable vitamins (Vitamin B complex, Vitamin ADE, Bo-Se)
- Newborn calf vaccinations (clostridium, intranasal, oral rota/corona)
- CD antitoxin
- Dextrose-50%
- Bander and bands
- Cast kit
- Acepromazine
- IV kit including catheter, tubing and fluids
- Calcium gluconate 23% or CMPK
- Lidocaine 2%
- Epinephrine
- Lutalyse
