

Equine Vaccinations:

Horses that are LOW risk for exposure to other horses should receive an EWT WNV (Eastern-Western-Tetanus West Nile Virus) + rabies

Horses that are HIGH risk for exposure to other horses should receive an EWT WNV (Eastern-Western-Tetanus West Nile Virus) + Flu/Rhino + rabies

Vaccinations should be annual. Spring is the ideal time if only vaccinating once per year. If you travel with your horse during the winter, it should have a flu/rhino booster in November as well.

When giving intramuscular shots to horses, we recommend you give it in the triangle of muscles in the neck.
